Painted panelling gets a city makeover in this Toronto condo bathroom. The unorthodox artwork placement, above a clean-edged plate rail, adds visual interest but keeps art away from splashes and direct steam. Individual walnut vanities wrapped in Bianco Carrara marble add warmth to the neutral space.

WHY WE LOVE IT: The panelled walls paired with luxe finishes make this urban bathroom feel like an escape to the country, without sacrificing comfort.
